# Upgraded Hams ready for cyclone Jal duty With 'Radio Modems' Hams Can Send E-mails & Images Too

Hyderabad: VU2 MUH, VU2 JOS, VU2 BL and VU2 MCW are on alert equipped with a hitherto never used facility during flood situations in Andhra Pradesh. With a cyclone situation developing in the state, Ham operators from the National Institute of Amateur Radio (Niar) in Hyderabad are all set to rush to whichever place their services will be requisitioned. The main job of the Ham operators is to establish a communication network between officials when there is a complete breakdown of link owing to floods. Unlike on previous occasions where only information could be relayed on a frequency that is exclusive for Ham operators, this time around even e-mails and images can be sent and received. As part of a nationa project funded by the department of information technology, Government of Îndia, for the first time Ham operators at this premier institute in the country have acquired what are called 'radio modems'. "This latest equipment will help us send e-mails and images which makes communication even more easy and better," S Rammohan, director, Niar who goes by the call sign VU2 MUH told STOI here on Saturday.

Hams Jose Jacob (VU2 JOS), Bhanumathi (VU2 BL) and Mukesh (VU2 MCW), who have had experience in helping out with communication during floods at several places in the country, are ready to be deployed in any district in the state where a severe flood threat looms large. In September, the Niar had intimated the chief minister that their services could be utilised whenever required. In the current developing situation, the Ham operators are waiting for a request to proceed to any place the administration specifically requests. With an amount of Rs two crore set apart by the department of information technology for acquiring sophisticated new technology to improve radio communication through Ham, the Niar also has plans to create awareness among NGOs and students to become part of the Ham radio network. Under this project, two client stations will also be set up - one at Srikakulam and another at Tenali from where Ham radio operators with the latest sophisticated network could rush to provide help through radio communication to the administration. The gateway station will be at Hyderabad from where the communication will take place, including sending of e-mails. The radio modems required for establishing e-mail contact will have to be imported for the plan to set up a network with all sophisticated equipment all over the country. "In Andhra Pradesh, we are closely studying the flood situation. As of now there are conflicting reports about the nature of the cyclone Jal. Depending on how it turns out, we will interact with the government to offer help," S Rammohan said.
